The High Price of Peace  
Romans 5:1-11

1. Romans 5:1 says that we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. What is peace? What have people done to try and gain it with God and with others?
2. The peace that God offers through Jesus provides us access to God. (Romans 5:2) Why was this necessary? How does this help you in times of need?
3. God's peace also brings rejoicing in hope and the Glory of God. In what ways can we rejoice because of our new relationship with him?
4. When we get saved, our relationship with God changes. We are justified and reconciled to God. What do these new conditions mean for our relationship with Him? What did God do to accomplish this?
5. God offers enduring peace. How does God express this? How does this provide hope in times of trials? (Romans 5:3-5)
6. How do we know that God wants us to be at peace with Him? (Romans 5:6-8)
7. Do believers ever act as enemies of God? If so, what is the answer for this? (James 4:4-8)
