1. Explain the Big Idea: “God’s judgment is the essential ingredient of the Gospel.”
2. In this text, Paul again argues that all are sinners without excuse. Why is this important for him to re-emphasize? How can failing to explain this lead to false conversions?
3. Read Romans 2:14-15. Even in this world, the most adherent atheist desires truth and wants their banker to be honest. Murder is universally condemned across all cultures, and justice is desired by all who claim to be moral. Is that what this verse is explaining?
4. Using the following definition from the Bible Believers Commentary, explain why you can’t let your conscience be your guide. “*Conscience is a person’s inner sense of right and wrong, given by God. Because human beings are made in God’s image, they reflect his moral standards. Nevertheless, conscience is not infallible. Conscience, like all elements of human nature, has fallen into sin. Therefore, its promptings are sometimes distorted, and even when accurate, people repress them unrighteous.*”
5. Explain Romans 7:19. Think of a time when you sinned on purpose, knowing full well that what you are doing is a sin. What is the solution to this problem according to 7:24,25?
6. The third point in the message was “All Secrets are Known.” Explain why this should drive us to Christ. Why is it important to state this when presenting the Gospel?
7. What is your biggest spiritual challenge?
