1. Explain the Big Idea: suppressing the truth opens the door to a downward spiral of sin. Can you give an example?

2. Why do you think Paul opened first with fornication and homosexuality (1:25-27) rather than the sins listed in 1:29-31?

3. What is Paul talking about in 1:24? Why are we supposed to keep our bodies clean and pure? Read 1 Cor 16:19-20.

4. Read 1:26-27 and explain dishonorable passions. Is it possible to have a tendency toward or struggle with homosexuality and it not be a sin? Why or why not? Why do you think the culture has embraced homosexual behavior as normal/acceptable? Is this worse than the culture embracing sexual relations outside of marriage between heterosexual couples?

5. Read Romans 1:32 and give an example of approving those that practice the abominable sins given in this chapter.

6. How can we as Christians live out the truths expressed in this portion of scripture in the spirit of truth and love?

7. Why is accountability important for the Christian? Do you have a prayer/accountability partner?
